



Showcase Information

- 1) **Friday Night Dancers** – Dress Rehearsal is Wed. May 27th.
Sr.Kinderdance, Pre-Primary, Primary, Jazz One, Jazz Two dancers – Arrive at the OSCVI at 4:30 to 6 pm.
Act One Dancers – Arrive at the OSCVI at 5:30 to 8:30 pm.
Act Two Dancers – Arrive at the OSCVI at 6:30 to 10 pm.
- 2) **Saturday Night Dancers** – Dress Rehearsal is Thurs. May 28th.
Sr.Kinderdance, Pre-Primary, Primary, Jazz One, Jazz Two Dancers – Arrive at the OSCVI at 4:30 to 6 pm.
Act One Dancers – Arrive at the OSCVI at 5:30 to 8:30 pm.
Act Two Dancers – Arrive at the OSCVI at 6:30 to 10 pm.
- 3) **Showcase Performance Times** – Friday May 29th and Saturday May 30th.
Act One arrive at the OSCVI at 5:30 pm. Act Two arrive at the OSCVI at 6:30 pm.
- 4) All dancers and volunteers are required to sign in and sign out when they arrive or leave the OSCVI.
- 5) **Make-up and Hair** –
Please do as much make-up and hair at home as possible! Leave lipstick until you arrive at the OSCVI.
Make-up – Foundation, black or dark brown mascara and eye liner, blush and lipstick in pink only.
Hair – All buns must have hair net and bobby pins. Bring your own hair brush, elastics, and hairspray or gel.
- 6) **Costumes** –
All costumes stay at the OSCVI between rehearsals and shows! You are not to take your costume home until your final showcase performance. Please remember to bring your dance shoes with you to dress rehearsal. Your shoes must stay with your costume.
No nailpolish, jewellery, tattoos, or underwear are to be worn for rehearsals and shows.
Garment bags are not to be taken home! Please bring an extra bag with you for your costume!
- 7) Parents, friends, dancers may not watch dress rehearsals! This is a rehearsal setting, and an audience is not permitted!
- 8) **Snacks** –
Dancers may bring snacks and quiet games to the rehearsals and shows. When bringing snacks, please send something that is not messy or will stain if spilled! ABSOLUTELY NO PEANUT PRODUCTS due to dancers with severe allergies.
List of acceptable snacks – bottled water, raw vegetables,apples, pears, dried fruit, cheese.
Unacceptable snacks – No peanut products, no chocolate, no drinking boxes, no lunchables.
- 9) **Pictures and DVD's** –
Charles van den Ouden will be present at Dress Rehearsals to take portraits of your dancers. Volunteers will escort each class for pictures to be taken. Please remember to send your photo order form and payment with your dancer on dress rehearsal nights.
Richard Thomas will be creating a DVD of the Showcase with all classes on it. Sign up sheet is on the bulletin board. Please bring your payment with you to the dress rehearsals.
- 10) Flowers will be available for parents to purchase in the lobby at the Showcase performances. Half dozen bouquet of roses, or mixed bouquets are \$15.
- 11) Dancers who are not in Act Two, may watch the second act as long as they have a ticket. This is due to fire and occupancy regulations in the auditorium. Dancers may not go into the audience with their costume on, and may sign out at intermission only.
- 12) All parents, volunteers, and senior dancers are invited to an end of season reception at the DanceMakers studio on Saturday May 30th after the Showcase performance. Help us celebrate another busy and successful year!
